RULES:

- Cost is \$10 per player due by Monday, January 28th. Checks payable to Newport Parks & Recreation.
- All participants must sign the attached waiver and be 16 years or older. Helmets are required (any type: bike, ski, hockey helmet etc. will do). Game equipment, sticks, nets and balls will be supplied by Newport Parks & Rec. Participants are responsible for their own personal safety equipment including knee pads (highly recommended), elbow pads, mouth guards etc. Broomball shoes or rubber, flat soled tennis or basketball type shoes suitable for running on ice are recommended. No skates, spikes, cleats or dangerous footwear is allowed.
- Goalie pads/leggings are not allowed. Hand protection is limited to the use of mittens or gloves. Softball gloves can be used by goalies; however no ice hockey goalie gloves or blockers can be used.
- Teams must be co-ed, up to 10 players, with a minimum of 6. Subs are highly recommended. At least two of each gender must be present on the ice at all times.
- Broomball is played in a 6v6 format with 5 players and one goalie (mandatory) for each contest. Games will consist of two 15-minute halves of running time, and one 5-minute half-time. No time-outs. In the event of a tie, one 5-minute, 5v5 (no goalies) sudden death over-time will determine the winner. If there is still no victor, a winner will be decided by coin toss. This is a double elimination tournament.
- Games will begin on time to ensure punctuality of the over-all tournament. Players or teams that arrive late to the start of the game will forfeit or be forced to play short-handed until more teammates arrive.
- Each team must declare one team captain to be responsible for relaying schedule and other information to teammates and reporting to the bracket station during the tournament. **Captains are also responsible for officiating at least one game during the tournament if needed, or designating a teammate to do so.** See below.
- Volunteer officials will be appointed to keep time, facilitate the rules, fair play and good sportsmanship. Volunteers are NOT professional referees, and must be treated with respect regarding any call or decision made. If any team fails to do so, they will forfeit the remainder of the game. Poor sportsmanship, fighting, excessive drinking, disrespect to the facilities or staff will result in the forfeit of one or all games and possible life-time suspension from the tournament. Full tournament rules can be requested by email.
