Newport Recreation Committee

The City of Newport is seeking applicants to fill vacancies on the Newport Recreation Committee. This Committee works closely with the Director of Parks & Recreation and serves as an advisory board to the Newport City Council on issues pertaining to parks and recreation. The group assumes a major role in developing a sense of community and enhancing the quality of life in our area by influencing the recreational future of Newport.

Applicants should be interested in local leisure programs, activities, special events, sports and facilities to meet the needs of the community. Formal education is not necessary, but some demonstrated experience or involvement in volunteerism, parks and recreation programs, projects or planning is preferred. All interested applicants must submit a letter of interest outlining their experience, qualifications and their desire to obtain a seat on the Committee.

General Information

The Newport Recreation Committee consists of 5-9 members, of which the majority must be Newport City residents. Members are appointed by the Newport City Council annually for two year staggered terms. This is a volunteer group and no members shall be compensated for their committee time.

The Recreation Committee meets monthly on the second Thursday at 6:00pm in the Newport Municipal Building, 222 Main Street. Onsite childcare during meetings will be available.
